

With 2018 in full swing I took some time to review 2017 at the Children's Home. In 2017 we had 54 children come through the doors of our Home. Fifty-four children whom we were blessed with the opportunity to love on, provide for, and ensure that they had everything they needed. A majority of these children came from neglectful situations where they did not have a safe home to live in or their basic needs met.

For many of these children, we were able to take them to church for the first time, or for the first time in a long time. For the first time we were able to pray with them and spend time doing family devotions. For many of them we were able to give them their very first Bible and teach them how to read it, use it, and love it. In 2017 we saw 16 children come to know Jesus Christ as their savior. We feel humbled, blessed, and extremely thankful that the Lord would allow us to have a small part in these children's salvation decisions.
